All competitors taking part in this tournament must have a valid up to date licence and insurance cover, and must be available for inspection on the day if required. It is the responsibility of the competitor and their coach to make sure the above are in order.

The organisers and referees cannot be responsible for any injury however caused.

Full Karate Rule can be found on WKF karate website.

- Yuko, Waza-Ari, Ippon scores will apply in the kumite Events
- Junior kumite events will be 1.5 mins seniors 2 mins, finals 2 minutes
- Kumite competitors may not enter outside their categories
- Kata, we may use the points scoring on some sections depending on amount of officials otherwise the flag system may be used.
- All 11years and under sections will only be allowed to perform Pinan or Heian Katas,
- 10 /11 years may enter up to 12/13 years kata, 12/13 years may enter up to 14/15 yrs kata, a 15 year old may enter up to senior kata.
- All kumite competitors will be required to wear the WKF style protective equipment for their age, face mask not compulsory, Gum Shield is compulsory.
- Only white karate gi will be allowed (Premier League Gi will not be allowed)
- Competitors must have up to date licence / insurance
- Amendments will not be allowed after the closing deadlines.
- Full entry fee as per your club entry must be paid.
- We encourage you to make your entry Via Sportsdata, this will give you the opportunity to amend your entry up until the closing deadline.

Travel to Worcester

Worcestershire's location in the heart of England makes it supremely accessible and closer than you think. If you are flying into the area, then Birmingham International Airport is approximately 40 minutes away, Manchester is 2h, Heathrow is 2h 10 and Gatwick is 2h 50 away.

From Birmingham International Airport:

Birmingham International airport is approximately 1.5 hours by train to Worcester. The easiest and cheapest route to take is a direct train from the airport to Birmingham New Street. From here there is a regular service to Hereford, which calls at Worcester stations.

The train will usually depart from platform 12 at Birmingham New Street, and takes around 50 minutes to get to Worcester stations.

The closest train station to the university is Worcester Foregate Street. From here a taxi can take you to the University of Worcester

Arena. University of Worcester Arena, Hylton Road, Worcester WR2 5JN The taxi ride should take you approximately 10 minutes and

it should cost around £7-£9 pounds. If arriving by train and you have the time, the walk from Worcester Foregate Street station to the arena takes approximately 25 to 30 minutes.
