### **Rules for Tournament Days**

- License: All competitors must produce a valid WSKF license with proof of age and grade.
- <u>Kumite weigh in</u>: We will operate weight checks. Any competitor found not to be the correct
  weight for the category they have entered will not be allowed to compete. We cannot move
  competitions to another weight category if they fail the weight checks
- <u>Belts and Mitts</u>: Mouth guards and mits(WKF approved) are compulsory, chest guards for female competitors 12+ are compulsory.
- Referees Briefing: 8.00 a.m.
- The event will start at 09:00 am promptly both days with kata/kumite
- Kumite will have staggered start times through the day.
- A full event schedule confirming start times will be published on Sportsdata prior to the event.
- Competitors in the first categories should be in the arena and ready to start at 8.30 am prompt. All
  other competitors should be in the arena a minimum of 1 hour prior to category scheduled start
  time. Should the event run ahead of schedule category start times may be brought forward.
  Competitor check in will be carried out prior to each category starting.
- Competitors are ONLY allowed to compete in their own age group
