- **Organizer:** Aruba International Karate Cup.
- **Date:** from Friday 15 to Sunday 17 November 2019
- **Schedule:** from 9:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m., during which time 4 courts will be competed simultaneously.
- **Event location:** Renaissance Convention Center, Oranjestad, Aruba.
- **Registration (athletes, teams, coaches):** will begin in the month of July and will run until the last week of October.
- **Cost per athlete:** USD 85
- **Regulation:** the competition will be disputed according to the Regulations of the World Karate Federation (WKF). All technical matters will be resolved under that regulation, having exceptions for the development categories.
- **Media:** We have set up the website www.arubakaratecup.com as an official means of information and dissemination.
- **Technical platform:** Sportdata.

NOTE:

The athletes could participate in categories of Development and Elite categories as long as they make the registration and the corresponding registration in each of these.

The organizing committee reserves the right to modify the adult and master categories according to the number of participants.

Awards:

- 105 gold medals
- 105 silver medals
- 210 bronze medals
- Special cash prizes for the 12 senior Elite categories.
- 3 cups for the teams that achieve the highest number of gold medals.



Regulation for Organizations that will participate

1. We will not accept registrations and corrections in the weighing or in the Congress; They will only be accepted if it is due to a transcription error committed by the organizers.
2. For weighing all elite athletes - without exception - must wear short and flannel, or lycra and top.
3. Elite athletes must use the overalls of their organization or country and athletic shoes at the awards ceremony.

Observations



- The event will be governed by the Regulations of the WKF.
- Athletes must present valid passport at the time of weighing.
- Coaches must be in the competition area properly uniformed, wearing a tracksuit (sports uniform) and credentials.
- It is convenient that the Competitors are insured. Aruba International Karate Cup 2019 are not responsible for any injury or accident that may occur before, during and after the event.
- It is responsibility of each organization or country to register their athletes.
- Each delegation must guarantee adequate clothing and protection, as established in the regulations.
- The access to the competition areas will be exclusive for the athletes and coaches according to the schedule agreed in the Technical Congress.
